What is Parentsportal?

The traditional school bag run has been used to facilitate communication between parents and schools for generations. Parentsportal provides a digital solution to this issue, making it easier for parents and carers to manage paperwork connected with school activities, and to obtain information about their child's educational progress at a time that suits them. The priority, as we introduce Parentsportal, is to enable parents to sign in and complete the Annual Data Check online. We will then be working on introducing additional services to the platform during 2024.

Our school is now live on Parentsportal, and links have been sent out via Groupcall Xpressions on how to sign up. This will make such a difference all round when it comes to the Annual Data Checks as we won't be sending home all the paperwork — it's good for the environment too as we won't be using reams of paper of the photocopier. Please don't hesitate to contact the school office for more information. So far, we have 80% of families signed up, so please take a few minutes to link in.
