Rag Bag

Just a reminder that we have a Rag Bag bin in the school playground. This helps our fundraising efforts for the year with Rag Bag paying the school for every kilo recycled. Swimming

Homework

Homework is part and parcel of school life here at Coylton Primary. We do understand that work commitments and busy family lives can be factors which can impact on homework tasks, and there is no obligation that tasks are completed, however if we can ask that as a minimum, all children have access to reading or having a story read to them daily at home - we absolutely see the positive impact of this in literacy activities back in school. PI pupils will receive log in details for Teams soon, but we will keep you posted. Formal homework tasks start on Monday 16th September – please get in touch if you are struggling to get onto Teams. Remember, it will take a bit of time for our PI pupils to get Glow accounts set up, so we will be in touch with PI parents as soon as we can.



School Photographs

I am pleased to say that we are able to have school photographers in to take individual and family photographs. Dates have been confirmed as Thursday 24th October and Friday 25th October. All children from EYC to P7 will have photographs taken, and a sample will come home. There is no obligation to purchase any. Because family groups will be taken, we are unable to guarantee which of the 2 days your children will be photographed. We would ask
