## School Improvement Planning

Each year, staff work together to evaluate how progress is being made across the school and EYC. We use various forms of data and listen to our pupils before agreeing our plan for the year ahead. This year, we will focus on the following:

LITERACY Year 2 of South Ayrshire Reads (in school) and Year I (in EYC), with a focus on Writing

NUMERACY with a focus on improving the understanding of number work and links to problem solving and real life contexts within school and EYC

HEALTH & WELLBEING with a focus on a Whole School and EYC Nurture approach.

In addition, staff will work on a programme called Adaptive Teaching where the focus will be identifying the various ways that pupils like to learn and adapting practice to meet their needs.

A visual representation of our School Improvement Plan is attached to the Round Up today, and you will have the chance to respond to it at our Meet and Greet on the II<sup>th</sup> September.



## School of Rugby

This session, we are pleased to be working with Ayr Rugby Club as part of their School of Rugby programme. This exciting initiative is being trialled in primary schools, and we are proud that Coylton Primary is one of the pilot schools. Our pupils will have the opportunity to attend taster sessions, and if they enjoy it, they can participate in the School of Rugby once a week during the school day. The aim of this programme is to encourage more children, particularly girls, to get involved in rugby.

Girls had their taster session yesterday. Boys will have their taster session next Thursday.



# News from the EYC (supplied by Kelly ©)

We are delighted to see how smoothly the children have transitioned into nursery and how well they have adapted to their new environment. As always, we are continually seeking ways to improve, and we would greatly appreciate it if you could take a moment to scan the QR code provided and share your feedback on the transition process.

This week in the EYC, we have been introducing the children to "The Colour Monster", which helps them recognise and understand different emotions. This approach allows us to support the children in identifying and expressing their feelings, fostering emotional awareness from an early age. Alongside this, we have been exploring the concept of friendships—what it means to be a good friend—through engaging activities such as painting, creating friendship bracelets, and reading stories.

In the coming weeks, your child's key worker will be reaching out to arrange a care plan meeting. This will be a valuable opportunity for us to discuss your child's progress and work together to set care plan goals tailored to their individual needs.

As always, we maintain an open-door policy and encourage you to reach out at any time throughout the year if you'd like to discuss your child's progress or seek any additional support.

In the coming months, there will be various opportunities to get involved, including meet-and-greet sessions, PEEP sessions, Book bug sessions, and Tea & Blether gatherings. We will also be conducting a survey to gather your thoughts on how we, as a team, can best support you—whether it's guidance on developmental milestones, managing fussy eating, or addressing behavioural challenges. Whatever the concern, we are here to help in any way we can, and we look forward to working in close partnership with you for the continued growth and well-being of your child.
