Icy Weather

We appreciate that at this time of year, the weather can become very cold and icy. Our janitor will always ensure that he salts paths to allow safe access into school. He will also do what he can to ensure that before morning break, the majority of playground areas are salted and safe for the children to use. We have a limited amount of salt this week with an order for more in place. Can we ask that on very icy mornings, children arrive at school from 8:50am and not earlier? If the playgrounds are not safe, we will have staff out to bring children into school earlier and we ask that if parents come with children, they stay with them until they are in school. Children will naturally want to slide on icy patches, but at that time in the morning, the salt may not have had the time to properly thaw all areas. I hope that you understand and support. If the salt has not been effective enough by morning break, children will not access the playgrounds. We would rather that they spend a break indoors than someone getting hurt



Great news! Miss McFarlane has been working with many classes across the school within the outdoor classroom and the school grounds. They have been awarded the Bronze Wild Challenge Award from the RSPB and a Schools For Nature certificate. The Schools For Nature certificate highlights schools that have taken action to protect and restore nature, signed by Sir David Attenborough. The RSPB award is because pupils have undertaken activities related to trying to 'help nature' and 'experience nature'. Children have gathered data on bugs, and created animal trackers to find animals living in our outdoor classroom. Pupils have also made bug hotels and built a mulch pit habitat for animals with more plans to create different habitats soon. We will proudly display these awards in school!
