Early Years Registration

Registration for Early Years in South Ayrshire opens on Monday 3rd March and closes on 9th March. South Ayrshire children have access to 1140 hours of funded early learning and childcare. Children who turn 3 between March – August 2025 are eligible to start in August 2025. Children who turn 3 between September 2025 - February 2026 are eligible to start the week after their 3rd birthday.

Rugby Festival


Unfortunately, the rugby festival was cancelled due to the wet and windy weather yesterday. We will keep you posted of a new date when we get it.




Charity Book Sale
