<u>2-3 room</u>

This week in the 2-year-old room we have been looking for little and big things. We have been exploring the difference between bigger and smaller items in our environment. We have been using the blocks to build different sized castle's and filling up containers to see which one held more and less. We have been able to identify "daddy" items and "baby" items.





3-5 room

In the 3-5 room we have been focusing on capacity. We have been looking at it through a variety of contexts using water and sand. The children have been practicing using mathematical language to describe how full their different sized container is. "full", "empty", "half full" and "nearly full". We are also beginning to explore weight using "heavy" and "light" to describe how heavy our toys are.
