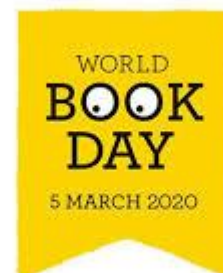
We would also like to allow each child the chance to bring in or wear one object, symbol or item of clothing that would represent a favourite character from a book, with this being used as part of discussions on the day.
