Dear Parents/Carers,



We have planned two Induction days for our Pre-school children and Parents / Carers in preparation for them going into P1 in August. The first day will be **Friday 9<sup>th</sup> May from 9.15-10.15am**. The second date will be **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> May from 10.45-12noon** where you will be able to join your child for lunch.

On the first day, Mrs Parker will provide you with general information including school routines, uniform and the P1 curriculum. There will be time at the end of this session for you to join your child in their new classroom and to meet their teacher Miss Muir.

On the second Induction day, Miss Muir will provide you with some practical advice on how to support your child with Literacy and Numeracy in the early stages of P1. As part of this session she will share with you the resources that we are going to be using and provide materials for you to support your child in preparation for moving into P1.

You are invited to attend both meetings where you will receive all of the key information about the P1 curriculum and the school systems as well as being able to have a look at the resources that your children will be using. As part of the second session on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> May**, you will have the opportunity to join your child for lunch at 11.30am which will allow you to sample the lunches and share in the dining hall experience.

The transition programme for the pre-school children has been ongoing throughout the year, with opportunities to work alongside P1 children. In preparation for starting P1 in August your child will be introduced to their Buddy during extended playtime sessions for Pre-school and P1. Their Buddy will be with them during the first few weeks of the new session in August to help them to settle into the routines.

As part of your child's transition programme they will be joining P1-3 in the playground, on **Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> and Friday 30<sup>th</sup> May and the whole school on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> June**. The children will be given the opportunity to play games with the other children and become familiar with the playground routines, prior to starting in August.
