We had a great time at our colour run event and enjoyed getting coloured and doing the obstacle course. Thanks for all your support with this.

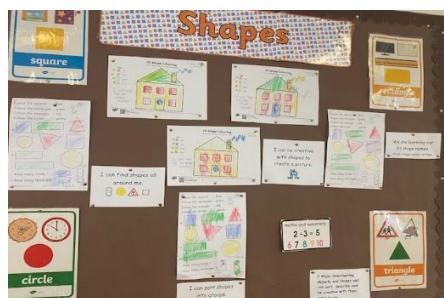


Our Learning- Health and Wellbeing
