PUPIL ABSENCE PROCEDURES – EARLY YEARS AND PRIMARY SCHOOL



If your child is unwell - or for another reason is not able to attend school or early years - it is **vital that you let us know** by telephoning our school office. Child safety is our very first priority and for this reason it is **essential that you contact us** if your child is going to be absent. If you do not contact the school, your child's absence will be recorded as unauthorised. School phone lines open at 8.30am and close at 3.30pm.

P.E. (PRIMARY 1 – 7 CLASSES)

All classes in the school will have three P.E. lessons each week.

P.E. kit:

Please may we ask that children bring the following PE kit to school on their PE days? Alternatively, you may wish to provide your child with a PE kit to keep in school.



- ✓ Shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms
- ✓ school polo shirt (or t-shirt) – children can come dressed in this
- ✓ gym shoes/plimssoles/trainers

P.E. Safety - Jewellery and Earrings: Children should not come to school wearing jewellery as this can be lost when children take it off and on. Where pupils have pierced ears, earrings must be removed for P.E; if it is not possible for earrings to be removed, we ask that children come to school with their earrings covered with micro-pore tape.

WATER BOTTLES – IMPORTANCE OF HYDRATION – EARLY YEARS AND PRIMARY SCHOOL

Children are encouraged to drink water throughout the day. We would be grateful if children could arrive at early years or school with their water bottles already filled. Should children require to refill their water bottles, a water cooler is available in our central corridor. Our NHS health promotion guidance recommends water rather than juice and explains 'Even low calorie drinks and no-added sugar drinks can encourage children to develop a sweet tooth'. Please label your child's water bottle with a permanent marker, such as a sharpie pen.



We have individual cups for our children in the early years centre. Alternatively, children in early years are also welcome to bring a labelled water bottle of their own.

P1-P7 CLASSES – MORNING SNACK

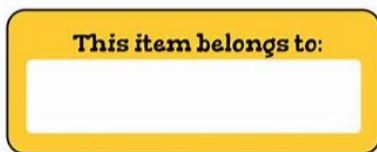
If you would like your child to have a morning snack, please may we ask that you pack a small healthy snack into your child's school-bag (rather than their packed lunch box)? School-bags are easier for the children to access at morning break. If children have a large snack at morning break, they often find that they are not hungry for lunch at lunchtime. Thanks in advance for your support.

ALLERGIES – IMPORTANT INFORMATION RE. NUTS AND NUT BASED PRODUCTS – EYC AND PRIMARY



We have several children and staff in school with very serious nut allergies. For some children, the allergy is airborne, meaning that an anaphylactic reaction could be triggered by being close to someone who is eating food containing nuts. We therefore ask for the support of all parents and carers in ensuring that children **do not bring nuts or products which may contain nuts** (such as Nutella, chocolate spread, chocolate bars containing nuts or snack/cereal bars containing nuts) to school for their snack or packed lunch. Thank you for your support.

LOST AND FOUND – PLEASE DON'T LOSE IT, LABEL IT



Please may we ask that all parents and carers take time to label all items of clothing (particularly jackets), packed lunch bags and school bags with your child's name? We find that writing names on items with a ball-point or sharpie pen works just as well as pre-printed labels. The labelling of items helps as it enables us to return misplaced items.

CAR PARK

The school car park is strictly for the use of staff and disabled badge holders. This is to limit the traffic within our car park which helps ensure the safety of all children.

CONTACT DETAILS AND MEDICAL INFORMATION



Please may I highlight the importance of school having up-to-date contact details for each child? **If any of your contact details change please notify the office as soon as possible.** Important information is often sent out via email and it is also vital that we are able to contact you (or your designated emergency contact) should your child become unwell.

MOBILE PHONES

The use of mobile phones by pupils during school time is not permitted. We ask for the support of all parents and carers in this by encouraging children to leave mobile phones at home. Where necessary, children are given access to the school phone through the school office. Where pupils are given permission by their parents to bring mobile phones to school, mobile phones should be turned off as soon as children arrive in the school playground in the morning until the end of the school day. Phones must remain in school bags and switched off.
