Improving Literacy:



Across our school and early years centre, our focus for improvement is on raising attainment in reading through implementation of the research based approaches recommended by South Ayrshire reads. This includes a focus on: interdisciplinary reading; vocabulary; reading fluency; phonological awareness and reading for enjoyment. We plan to refresh all of our class libraries in partnership with the children.

Last session, we worked hard to achieve a 'Silver Scottish Book Trust Reading Schools' award. Our aim is to progress this further by striving for 'Scottish Book Trust Reading School Gold Level' accreditation for our school and early years centre over the next two years.

Improving Numeracy:

This session, our focus is on improving numeracy through staff professional learning on the use of manipulatives and 'Think Boards'. We also aim to improve the children's learning by reducing unnecessary cognitive load.

Improving Attendance – Every Learner Every Day



In Dundonald, we know that going to school is a great way to prepare children and young people for the future. We are promoting South Ayrshire's 'Every Learner, Every Day' campaign to highlight the benefits of going to school and the importance of good attendance.
