LITERACY:



We are developing our mark making skills in the cafe/ role play area, some of our children are starting to take an interest in trying to write their name. We are taking part in Book Week Scotland and Nursery Rhyme Week and will share our favourite stories and rhymes. This term we are learning new songs for our nativity and the Dunure light switch on with Mrs Coleman, hope to see you all there.

NUMERACY:



This term our focus is on numerals to 10, touch counting and identifying. The children are also exploring the numbers to 10 in French and are very good at remembering these. We are learning about pattern in numbers and shapes using real objects and games on the interactive board. We use what we learn whilst we are in the playroom or in the outdoors and can identify pattern in our environments.

HWB

We are learning to keep safe and assess risks. We have used what we learn while talking about Fireworks and Halloween. The children are going to be doing their own risk assessments for the playground and during discussions for our outdoor learning days. PC McGinley came to visit and spoke about road safety and is bringing her police car back to show us.
