

# P4-7 TERM 2

## LITERACY

Our class novel is Eurospies by Lyndsay Littleton. Pupils will develop their comprehension skills through this story and will also read aloud three times per week using other texts to build confidence and fluency.

In phonics, we are continuing our 'South Ayrshire Reads' journey, which will support pupils in improving both their reading (decoding) and writing/spelling (encoding) skills.

This term, our writing focus is creative texts. We will explore and create effective settings, characters and plots. We will also be writing thematic paragraphs linked to our values in phonics sessions.

## TOPIC

This term, our class is taking an exciting journey through Europe! We're exploring the continent's countries, cultures, languages, and famous landmarks, while comparing them to life here in Scotland. Pupils are discovering both the similarities—like shared traditions and ways of living—and the differences, such as language, food, and climate. Along the way, we're also learning how Scotland connects with Europe through trade, travel, and cultural links, helping us understand our place in a bigger world.

## NUMERACY

This term, our focus is on multiplication, division, information Handling & money.

We take a thinking classroom approach that encourages curiosity, collaboration and critical thinking. We focus on understanding, reasoning and problem-solving — not just getting the right answer.

We use a concrete–pictorial–abstract (CPA) approach, ensuring pupils develop a deep and flexible understanding of mathematical ideas.
