


P1-3 TERM 3

LITERACY

As part of our South Ayrshire Reads journey, we will be focusing on improving fluency in reading. Children will take part in daily fluency boost sessions which are designed to improve accuracy, automaticity and prosody.



Our weekly writing will again link with our topic and we will cover a number of different styles. From writing fact files, to thank you letters to those that help us.



NUMERACY

With Mrs Holland, we have been learning all about pattern and symmetry. We are now learning about money and enjoyed setting up our own Supermarket Role Play to practice counting money and giving change.



With Mrs Martin, we are continuing to focus on number. Primary 1 are exploring a wider range of numbers and being able to put these in order. Primary 2 and Primary 3 will explore multiplication and division.

TOPIC



We began this term with a short topic on Scotland. Pupils enjoyed creating a Scottish Cafe in the role play area and learning about Scottish artists. They researched Robert Burns and created Fact Files as well as learning their own Scottish Poems.
