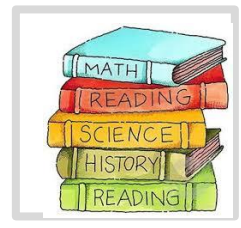

Literacy

- Write about your Christmas holidays and illustrate it with a picture. Remember to use correct punctuation, finger spaces and take care with letter sizing and handwriting.

- Create a mind map with as many words as you can for your sound.
- Choose a spelling activity from the spelling menu to work on your spelling words for this week. Remember to work on letter formation too. If possible, get an adult to test you on your spelling words on Friday!
- Read 'A Dug A Dug' by Bill Keys and listen to it being read aloud. Search Scots words you would like to know the meaning of using the Scots online dictionary.
