Writing:

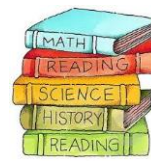
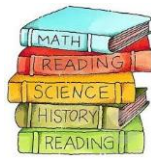
- Write your own Scots poem. Use 'A Dug, A Dug' for inspiration – could you write a poem about another animal? Use a Scots dictionary if you need help translating words
