- Log in to Education City

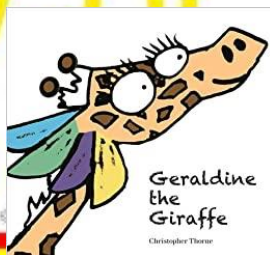

When buying something, you need to make sure you have enough money.



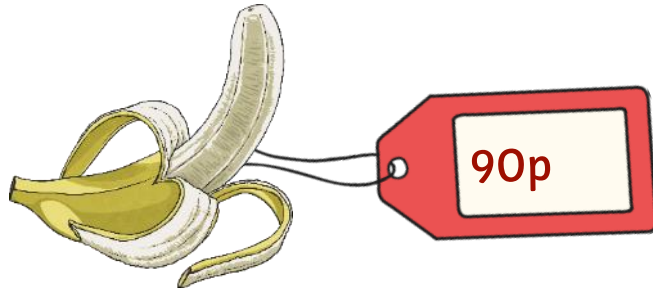
You do not need to have **exactly** £1.50, you could have any amount that is more than this.

If you had a £5 note, you could use this to pay for the item. You also need to get back the extra amount you paid on top.

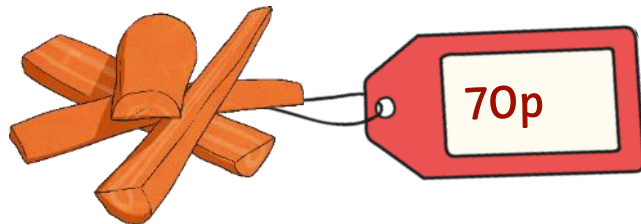
