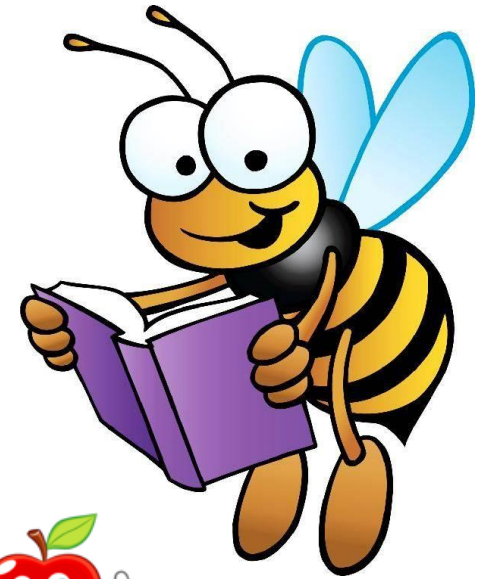
You are going to draw a picture of the White Witch who we read about in Chapter 3. Around the picture of the witch, write some adjectives to describe her.
