Free Book

We are asking children to wear their favourite pyjamas or, if they would rather, a World Book Day costume. Pupils will be asked to bring their favourite book into school to show and read at a point throughout the day.

Reading time during the day

Children will be given time to read in class before lunch in a 'Relax and Read' session. The book can come from home or be selected from the library

We are holding a school competition to design your own book character. There will be a separate prize for the lower school and the upper school.
