There will be lots of exciting opportunities across the school for pupils to be involved. However, for those who want to be part of the cast and crew, due to the playing age of the characters, we are only able to offer this to children in Primary 5 – 7.

Auditions will be held for cast members and there will also be some jobs available for those looking to help backstage. To give you as much information as possible we have uploaded all the details about the auditions to the school website, just head to the Pupil Groups tab, where you will find a School Show page with everything you need, including; a brief description of the characters, a link to the audition song, and a short piece of dialogue that the children will be asked to perform at the audition (boys/girls). They will not have to memorise this at the audition stage and can use the script. If you have any questions, or require a paper copy, please contact Mr Bell or Miss Eggo.

Pupils **must** be available from 02/06/25 – 06/06/25 for the show week and must also be prepared to commit to rehearsals. These will take place after school on a Monday and Wednesday until 4.30pm and principal cast may be called for extra rehearsals on a Thursday. If you are unable to commit to this, please consider carefully if a principal role would be right for your child.

Attached to this letter is a permission slip, which gives permission for your child to take part in the show and to attend all rehearsals. It also contains an options form to indicate what your child would like to do in the show. Please complete and return this by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2025.

This is great opportunity for the young people to be involved in presenting a high-quality show allowing them to experience being on a stage, performing for an audience and participating in a musical production.
