Welcome to our September Newsletter. We are now settled in our new building and staff and pupils are absolutely loving our new learning environment. We are working on a few areas in the school - organising set ups and resources and creating specific learning areas. Our Primary 7 pupils have had a great view of the old Portakabin classrooms being removed. Demolition of the old building commenced on the 12th September and will consist of a 4 week soft strip period, followed by a further period where the excavator will move in to demolish the building and remove all materials from site.



Prestwick North Campus

Moving into a shared campus is a new experience for everyone - pupils and staff. Through time we will become more familiar with working as a shared campus and we already have lots of plans to share experiences and events across both schools. At the moment we have no plans to share playtimes and lunchtimes across both schools due to the lack of space and school assistant provision both schools have. We will review this in the future when the campus is completely finished and we have more playground space and the astro turf pitch.

Parents/carers in the playground

Our pupils have become more confident in the playground in the morning and we ask that after the September break we have Primary 1 parents/carers **ONLY** entering the school grounds. This is a joint campus decision and St. Ninians Primary will also only have Primary 1 parents in the playground in the morning.

The afternoon arrangements for all parents/carers collecting children remains the same. Both gates at the back will be 'manned' by a school assistant and there will be lots of staff in the playground and the gate at the Sherwood Road entrance from 8.45am to assist the children.

Parking around campus

We have been really lucky with the weather coming back to school with lots of parents/carers/families all enjoying the walk to school! We have lots of pupils travelling to school on bikes and scooters, many with helmets, which is also great to see. With the increase in numbers of pupils attending both schools and the EYC we ask that consideration is taken when parking around the campus to ensure the safety of all our children. We would like to encourage everyone to park further away from the campus and walk using the crossing patrols around the area - even when it is raining!!

The programme allows class teachers to monitor reading levels and assess next steps in learning for all our learners. Across the school there is a positive reading ethos and pupils enjoy reading for lots of different purposes and for enjoyment. We are currently setting up reading areas across the school and as part of the School Development Plan will develop accelerated reader at our Primary 2 stage.
