Classes and Staffing for Session 2023/24

We will soon be looking at class structures for next session. At the moment we are waiting on confirmation from the authority to finalise our staffing structure and entitlement for the year ahead so we are not yet in a position to organise classes. We are hoping that we will be able to move on this by the end of May.

As you know when we are organising classes we focus on the learning needs of all pupils. We will keep pupils and parents/carers fully up to date when we begin to organise our classes and staff.

New Primary 1 Pupils

We have 41 new Primary 1 pupils registered for Glenburn and our transition programme to welcome our new cohort of children in August 2023 is underway. Mrs Blackwood and our Primary 1 teachers will be visiting the Early Years Centres and we have organised for our new children to come in on transition days in June.

Wednesday 10th May at 6.30 pm where parents/carers will be able to meet staff in the school, have a tour of the school and visit our P1 classrooms.

BE Uniforms will also be in attendance at the information evening with uniform samples and to give uniform advice.

Primary 7 Transition

Throughout the year our Primary 7 pupils have taken part in many planned, interesting transition activities at Prestwick Academy. The pupils now have a good feel of the building and this term provides the pupils with 3 full days at the academy following their timetables. Transition days are Tuesday 13th, Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th of June. Our Primary 7 pupils will also have visits from English and Maths teachers and a chance to go and see the matinee production of 'Beauty and the Beast 'at the academy.



Traditionally we host our Leaver's Assembly in the church, however with 74 pupils there is not enough room to accommodate everyone. So, this year our Leaver's Assembly will be in our school hall on Wednesday 28th June at 1.30 pm. We can accommodate no more than 2 family members per child for our Leaver's Assembly. Parking Around Campus



We continue to monitor the parking around the campus ensuring that our main priority is that our pupils are safe at all times.

Our JRSO have been campaigning round the school for our young people to use the school crossing patrols that we have in place. There are 2 crossing patrollers on Sherwood Road and one on Shaw Road and we would encourage parents/carers to park away from the main school streets of Sherwood Road and Langcroft

pupils/parents/carers can 'park and stride' without the main school streets becoming crowded and dangerous. More pupils are cycling and scooting to school in the better weather - this is great 🐯

School Grounds

We are very proud of our new school grounds and our pupils are doing a fantastic job of respecting and looking after the grounds during and after the school day. Our staff love seeing the pupils using the school we are a community. We make a difference. grounds after school and taking care of it. During Citizenship, pupils



are reminded about the rules of the school grounds and that this is also encouraged outwith school times. By keeping the back gates open at 3.00 pm and weekends we hope that pupils can enter and leave the grounds safely. We have been provided with extra bins on our astro turf pitch encouraging the young community to keep it clean and tidy. We have CCTV cameras covering all the school grounds 24 hrs a day so we can keep anti-social behaviour at bay. We would also encourage parents/carers to reiterate the importance of respecting the school grounds if playing outwith school hours.

King's Coronation Celebration - Friday 5th May



After our successful jubilee celebrations last year, we have decided on the same format for the coronation. We are having an afternoon tea and playing organised fun games. This event has been planned across the campus with Glenburn and St. Ninians joining together for the event - the EYC will also celebrate on the same day. We are asking pupils to dress up in their fancy clothes or red, white and/or blue. Lunch that day will be sandwiches, sausage rolls and cake. When ordering

Parent's Evening





As a staff, we continue to look closely at the attainment and achievement of all children in school and monitor closely who receive free meals and families who live in postcodes indicating highest levels of deprivation. An
