#### <u>Literacy - South Ayrshire Reads</u>

We are working alongside colleagues in the South Ayrshire Reads Team and within the cluster to raise attainment in literacy and close the literacy attainment gap between the most and least

disadvantaged children and young people in South Ayrshire. As part of our own school development plan we will be developing our approaches to assessing reading and looking at innovative ways to encourage reading for enjoyment, while also rearranging the reading environment within the school. We will also be further developing our approaches to assessing for and supporting Dyslexia while working towards the South Ayrshire Dyslexia

#### **SAMSON Maths**



As part of our ongoing maths development we have introduced SAMSON mental maths across the school. SAMSON maths is a supporting resource for mental maths. The resource gives structure to mental maths that provides coherence and progression across all levels - a consistent method of teaching mental maths from Primary 1 to 7.

The aim of SAMSON maths is for all children to have sound mental maths strategies and be confident with paper and pencil procedures. The progressive structure of SAMSON helps pupils tackle and solve problems, helps with textbook work and also helps when pupils are working independently.
