As a school we cannot stress enough how regular attendance is absolutely vital for your child's academic development and progress. We understand that children may be absent from school due to illness and this is inevitable especially at this time of year. However, across the authority and the country there has been a significant increase in pupil absence in both primary and secondary.

Every Learner Every Day

South Ayrshire are tracking attendance in schools and ensuring schools have measures in place to promote attendance in schools and also support pupils/families where attendance levels are low. If your child is going to be absent from school please inform the school office through a phone call or message on the Xpressions APP.



This month, if your child has fallen below 80% attendance you will receive an authority letter making you aware of your child's low attendance.

If you want your child to be successful in school then attendance DOES MATTER.

The table below outlines attendance percentage against learning lost and the impact it has on learning.

95-100% attendance	Best chance of success	Your child is taking full advantage of every learning opportunity.	
90-95% attendance	At least 2 weeks of learning missed	Satisfactory. Your child may have to spend time catching up with work.	
85-90% attendance	At least 4 weeks of learning missed	Your child may be at risk of underachieving and may need extra support from you to catch up with work.	
80-85% attendance	At least 5 ½ weeks of learning missed	Your child's poor attendance has a significant impact on learning.	
Below 80% attendance	At least 7½ weeks of learning missed	Your child is missing out on a broad and balanced education. You are at risk of prosecution.

below. We look forward to seeing you there.


