PARKING AROUND CAMPUS



Our car park is for staff and blue badge holders only. We have had a number of parents/carers across the campus parking in the disabled parking spaces in the campus without holding a blue badge. Similarly, people are also parking in designated taxi spaces. This has, at times, prevented pupils being dropped off in the disabled bays or at the end of the day preventing pupils getting to their taxi or car who really

need to access the vehicle quickly and safely. Please do not park in the campus car park at 9am and 3pm, especially in the designated disabled and taxi spaces unless in possession of a blue badge to allow parking in a disabled space.

REPORTING TO PARENTS/CARERS

As you know our class teachers, pupil support teachers and senior management team strive to keep you up to date about your child's learning, especially where there are concerns and targeted support is put in place. Equally, we encourage parents/carers to get in touch any time during the school year if you have any concerns regarding progress in learning or any welfare concerns. Class teacher reports and parents' evening is scheduled for May 2024, however please do not hesitate to contact the school if you would like a meeting with your child's class teacher this term or with Mrs Fullard our Pupil Support Teacher, likewise class teachers will be in touch with parents/carers this term regarding targeted support.
