


Glenburn Primary School News March 2024

Ayrshire Music Festival


We have 2 groups of pupils attending and taking part in the Ayrshire Music Festival this year.

CITIZENSHIP



Pupil views are very important to us and as a staff team we strive to not only listen to our pupil views but also to respond in a positive way. Sometimes, pupil views are out of our hands i.e. an outdoor swimming pool and a horse paddock!! However, we are always listening and improving experiences for our learners.

Before Christmas pupils were voicing their views that Citizenship was too long. Our house captains worked together gathering

different ideas on how to improve the hour a week of Citizenship. We now have a new way of engaging in citizenship and this is proving to be very successful and enjoyable for all pupils.

All pupils arrive at Citizenship at 1.45 pm on a Monday afternoon. Mr Martin and Mrs Blackwood share school news, pupil of the week and wider achievement with all pupils. At 2.05 pm our P7 pupils lead different activities across the school environment for small groups of children. This is done on a 3 weekly cycle i.e. P1 and P2 groups for 3 weeks. The other year groups not involved in the activities remain in the hall and engage in activities relating to SHANARRI and also have the chance for outdoor play for remaining 15 mins. The pupils are enjoying working with each other in different stages and experiencing different activities set up and led by our P7 pupils. Some activities include, art, block play and construction
