



Primary 2 Curriculum Newsletter August - October 2021



Literacy

We will start by revising some of the phonemes we learned in P1 before moving on to learn a new sound every week. We will also learn to spell more common words. Reading will continue with one book being sent home to read and one staying in class for us to use for daily writing tasks. Our class book is 'Where the Wild Things Are' and we will use this as a stimulus for writing and links to drama and listening and talking. In Spanish, we will be learning greetings, sharing information about ourselves, and numbers to 20.

<u>Numeracy</u>

Our main focus this term will be place value. We will learn to count in different ways, for example forwards and back, in tens, in fives in twos and starting from any number. We will learn to write two-digit numbers correctly with the tens and ones digits in the correct order. There will also be a focus on estimation and rounding numbers to the nearest ten. We will also be learning different strategies for addition and subtraction.
