Literacy

This term we will be reading the novels Cosmic or George's Secret Key to the Universe. We will be continuing to use Talk for Writing strategies to explore the techniques used to help us write our own 'Wishing Tale.'

Spelling will be on a four-week rotation, looking at common and tricky words, subject specific words, affixes, homophones and spelling rules.
