### Literacy

For the first five weeks after the October holidays, Primary 7 will be continuing to develop their skills in writing. This term we are using the Talk for Writing, non-fiction process to write information reports. These reports will also allow children to develop skills in research, as they will be finding information in their chosen topic for the report during our ICT time. During this term, we will also continue using the Active Literacy comprehension strategies while investing a novel. We will be focusing on Inference and theme.

# Numeracy

As part of our Winter Wonderland Enterprise context for learning, we will be taking a close look at budgeting. The children will learn about costings and how to successfully make a profit.

Following that, we will move on to multiplication and division and will develop our understanding of the different strategies we can use to successfully calculate both operations.

#### IDL -Biodiversity

At Dolphin House, the Primary 7's began learning about the different species of plants and animals that are located on the Scottish coast. We will continue to learn about plant and animal species in different habitats when we return to school. We will then move on to planning our Winter Wonderland event!
