October - December 2021



Literacy This term for phonics and spelling, we will start by consolidating our learning from the first term. We will then learn ue, aw, oi, au, ew, ow and ou. We will continue to look at the most common words for spelling. We will continue to send 1 reading book home and focus on a second book in class. Our Talk for Writing focus will be linked to Traditional Tales. We will be working on writing sentences with the correct structure and punctuation.

Numeracy Our main numeracy focus will be place value, investigating how whole numbers are constructed. We will develop our use of number lines, counting on and back and answering a range of addition and subtraction calculations within 20. Fact families will be explored, reinforcing the children's knowledge and quick recall. We will use a range of concrete materials to develop the children's thinking skills and support their use of mathematical vocabulary. We will explore 3D objects in real life contexts and discuss their properties.
