Re: Annual Parents Survey

We are delighted with the very positive results and comments from this year's parent survey. We received 114 returns, a decrease of 64 from last year.

Questions scoring 90% and above were as follows:

- My child likes being at this school 100%
- Staff treat my child fairly and with respect 95%
- I feel that my child is safe at the school 98%
- The school helps my child to feel confident 98%
- I feel staff really know my child as an individual 91%
- My child finds their learning activities hard enough 92%
- My child receives the help they need to do well 94%
- My child is encouraged to be healthy and take regular exercise 98%
- My child is making good progress at school 96%
- I feel comfortable approaching the school with questions, suggestions and/or a problem 96%
- I am satisfied with the quality of teaching in the school 95%
- The school is well-led and managed 98%
- The school encourages children to treat others with respect 96%
- I would recommend the school to other parents 97%
- Overall, I am satisfied with the school 98%

Questions where the scores were lower than 80%:

- I receive helpful information about how my child is doing 73%
- School staff help my child develop skills to keep themselves safe online 74%
- The school organises activities where my child and I can learn together 65%
- The school takes my views into account when making changes 78%
- I feel encouraged to be involved in the work of the Parent Council 78%
