*** Primary 1 registration: session 2024-2025 ***



Children whose 5th birthday is between 1 March 2024 and 28 February 2025 should be registered for education during the week commencing *Monday 15 January 2024.*

You should register your child online for either your catchment denominational or non-denominational primary school between Monday 15 January and Friday 19 January. You will be asked to attach your child's birth certificate and proof of residence in the catchment area in the form of a Council Tax Notice and Utility Bill during the on-line registration process.

If you intend to defer your child's entry to Primary 1 for a further year you **do not** need to register your child for education but you **must** complete the deferred entry application online which will be available week beginning 15 January and should be submitted no later than Friday 23 February 2024.

Group Areas

From January, some of our children's group areas within the playroom will change. This ensures that all children benfit from a mix of open plan and table top focused learning experiences. This change is beneficial to children who are preparing for Primary 1 and allows all children to demonstrate a range of skills as they learn.

Swimming Sessions (pre-schoolers)

Begins: *Monday 15th January (5 weeks – occurs every Monday)*

Additionally, pre-school children have the opportunity to attend 5 swimming sessions at Prestwick Swimming Pool at a cost of £2.50 per sessions. We kindly ask that £12.50 is paid in full prior to the first session. A limited number of spaces are available.

Sessions begin at 10.30am and finish at 11.30am. Children will walk to and return from the pool with Heathfield EYC staff. Prestwick Swimming Pool has asked that fmailies do not attend due to lack of seating. Children will have lunch upon their return.

Coming up: *Thursday 25th January*


