

Positive Relationships Policy

Our Positive Relationship Policy and Anti Bullying Policy are available on the school website.

Pupils are rewarded with individual points and House Points. When a pupil achieves 30 points they receive a Depute Headteacher Award and when they achieve 40 points they receive a Headteacher Award and a 'Treat Time'.

Low level misdemeanours are recorded on a tracking sheet and collated each week. More serious incidents are dealt with on an individual basis. During this term we will be reviewing this process, through consultation with pupils and their families.

Entry and Exit Doors

All Primary 1 and 2 pupils will enter through the door at the back of the school (immediate right as you enter the car park). The Primary 3-7 pupils enter through doors as follows:

First door turning right from Reception – P7

Second Door turning right from Reception – Primary 4 & 6

Third door turning right from Reception (across from EYC entrance) - P3 & 5
