Red Nose Day is an annual campaign that raises life-changing funds to help end the cycle of poverty and ensure children are safe, healthy, educated and empowered across the world. We will be exploring a range of UNCRC Articles through the context of Red Nose Day including:

- ☐ Article 6 Every child has the right to life, survival, and development.
- ☐ Article **24** The right to healthcare, nutritious food, and clean water.
- Article **26** The right to benefit from social security and financial support if needed.
- ☐ Article **27** The right to an adequate standard of living.
- ☐ Article **28** The right to education

Pupils from Primary 2 to 7 will attend the Oval for a Fun Park Run, and Primary 1 and P1Y and P2–4M will have an obstacle course on the playground.

Members from the Parent Voice Group will meet this Friday, 14th March, to discuss Home Learning and agree the questionnaire.


