Parking has been a challenge at Heathfield for some time, and last year our Parent Voice group raised concerns with South Ayrshire Council and Ayrshire Roads Alliance. Thanks to their letter (shared by our Junior Road Safety Officers), we've had a very positive meeting and agreed on some next steps.
