Please ensure that children have their PE kit in school. No football strips should be worn.

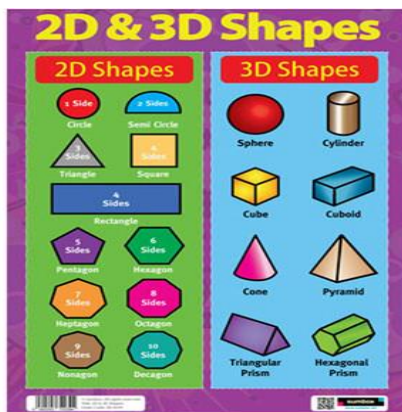
OUR CURRICULUM THIS TERM

Literacy and English

Listening and Talking: We will be listening to and watching texts, recognising facts and opinions.

Reading: Reading groups will be assigned reading books at their reading level and will use the text to develop the decoding skills, fluency and comprehension. We will continue to consolidate our knowledge of sounds and their different written representations.

Writing: We will learn to write reports using scientific experiments as our context.



Numeracy and Maths

Number and Number Processes: We will focus on addition and subtraction this term, learning new strategies to use when working with two and three digit numbers.

Expressions and Equations: We will compare numbers using different symbols and solve missing number calculations.

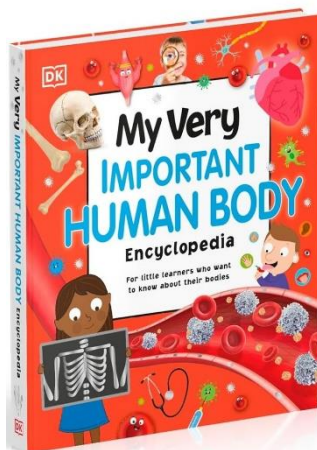
Angles: We will learn to identify a right angle, acute and obtuse angles.

Health and Wellbeing

In **PE** our focus will be on fitness and social dancing. As part of our human body context, we will learn about physical health and hygiene.

RRS: Articles 2 and 30, to understand fairness, identity and respect for differences.

RRS: Articles 3 and 6, to develop understanding of how Children in Need supports the rights of children and family.



Contexts for Learning

The Human Body: With a focus on science and health and wellbeing, we will learn about our bones, muscles and organs. We will also learn about our senses and staying healthy. The children would love to hear from some expert parents about jobs that use knowledge of the human body. Materials: Focusing on technologies and science, we will learn about the properties of different materials and carry out experiments.
