OUR CURRICULUM THIS TERM

Literacy and English

We continue our South Ayrshire Reads (SAR) phonological awareness journey. Growing our knowledge, vocabulary and skills in early reading and developing a love of stories and language. Please keep looking out for our sound of the week on Evisense.

We will be placing a focus on developing our vocabulary, writing our names/surnames, and short words. We will co-create longer texts with symbols.



Numeracy and Maths

This term for numeracy we will be learning to share amounts equally and comparing the length of objects and ourselves.

We will be learning about numbers to 40, as well as adding and subtracting to 10 and beyond. We have already started to learn about time; days of the week, and what we do each day.



Health and Wellbeing

For Health and Wellbeing this term, Miss Cameron will be focusing on Personal Care. We will learn how to wash our hands and face, zip our jackets and use buttons, put our shoes on and brush our own hair. We will increase our responsibility and independence by the end of the year 😊



Contexts for Learning

This term begins with learning about seasonal change and festivals.

We will then move our focus to 'Witches and Wizards'. Learning to read and write spells before following them. Developing and extending our skills in imaginative play and role play, through building our own magic castle and magical kitchen.
