OUR CURRICULUM THIS TERM

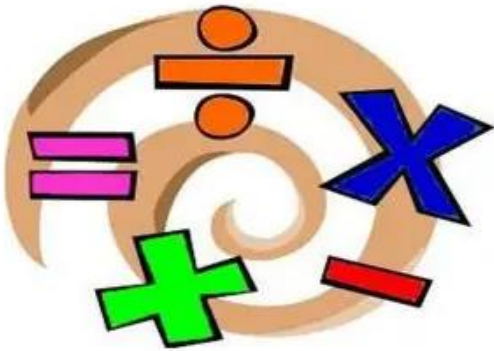
Literacy and English

Following on from a successful Term 1, we will be continuing to develop our knowledge and retention of phonemes and digraphs using the South Ayrshire Reads (SAR) approach to literacy as well as a variety of daily encoding (spelling), decoding (blending) and writing tasks which the learners are becoming more familiar with.

Learners will also continue to develop their reading skills using our reading scheme, a range of individual and group work as well as reading for enjoyment daily.



Math Operations



Numeracy and Maths

Learners have all made progress in term 1 which is great news.

This term we will be focussing on number including the operations of addition and subtraction as well as extending learning to begin exploring multiplication and division.

Furthermore, learners will increase their knowledge of shape and time. This will involve naming, identifying, and classifying a range of 2D and 3D shapes as well as telling the time on both analogue and digital displays with varying levels of support.

Health and Wellbeing

The learners are now familiar with our consistent routines which lets them know what to expect most of the time. This term we are going to have a focus on the human body as well as continuing to develop positive relationships with one another including how to keep friendships that have been formed.

We are also going to explore situations which are safe and dangerous, learning about who can help us.

We continue to use Zones of Regulation as part of our daily routine which means we are constantly talking about a range of feelings and emotions and how we can deal with them



Contexts for Learning



This term the children have asked to learn about the Arctic. We will be comparing climates including exploring weather and seasons.

We will learn about animals who live in the Arctic including their habitats and food chains.

We will learn about people who live in the Arctic including their lifestyle and housing.

We will learn about the environment including caring for it and the changing states of water.
