OUR CURRICULUM THIS TERM

Literacy and English

Listening and Talking


We will continue to develop our notetaking skills, with a particular focus on the Holocaust. We will also be learning and performing the Scottish poem 'Address to The Toothache' by Robert Burns.

Reading


Currently, we are reading 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas' by John Boyne and further developing our skills in the use of the comprehension strategies. We will also begin our transition novel, 'Show Us Who You Are' by Elle McNicoll.

Writing

This term, we will focus on creating non-fiction texts where we will be developing our understanding of discursive and persuasive writing.



Numeracy and Maths



This term, we will develop our skills in finding the area and perimeter of basic and compound shapes. We will learn about fractions, focussing on finding fractions of amounts, converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers and developing our understanding of adding and subtracting fractions. Additionally, we will cover percentages and making the link between decimals, fractions and percentages.

We will also look at time and timetables. Finally, we will develop our understanding of negative numbers and will have experience of solving problems involving integers.


Health and Wellbeing

In PE, the children will be developing their skills in gymnastics and basketball before moving on to focus on volleyball and netball. We will also start our annual Sports' Championship, the content of which will be decided upon by the children.

This term, the children will participate in the NSPCC Online PANTS workshop and follow-up lessons, will focus on Holocaust Memorial Day and Childrens Mental Health Week. We will also continue to develop our understanding of the children's rights.



Contexts for Learning



Linking to our prior knowledge of World War 2, throughout January, we will be focusing on the Holocaust. We will also be exploring key Scottish people and/or places.

During term 3, the children will also have the opportunity to participate in an elective of their choice.
