OUR CURRICULUM THIS TERM

Literacy and English

Through the SAR (South Ayrshire Reads) approach we have been able to see progress with learners retaining and becoming more confident in a range of encoding and decoding activities.

Reading circles will continue weekly along with daily reading tasks blended with L&T/Writing and other curricular areas.

This term learners will focus on developing their imaginative story writing alongside daily opportunities to write and record including diaries.



Numeracy and Maths

Our Numeracy focus for term 3 will be across several different areas of maths and numeracy:

We will focus on time, including recognising and telling the time on both digital and analogue displays. In addition, we will improve our concept of time by referring to calendars for important upcoming events.

We will investigate fractions including using pictorial representations to demonstrate understanding of halves/quarters etc.



Health and Wellbeing

Learners have demonstrated some increasing maturity in terms 1 and 2. This term we hope to have a focus on life skills including daily hygiene routines such as brushing teeth. In addition, we will learn about food hygiene and preparation as well as exploring different types of foods.

We are going to teach learners about other life skills including important tasks which build independence eg. folding clothes, making toast, hoovering, washing dishes etc.

We will continue to focus on the concept of transition as our P7 Learners edge closer to their journey towards secondary school.



Contexts for Learning

Term 3 signals the start of a new year and as such, January provides us with the opportunity to focus on all things Scottish. This will include a poetry assembly at the end of the month and learners will investigate topics such as Robert Burns, Scottish music, Scots dialect and local history.

Furthermore, we will then move onto Space where the learners will decide what aspects they wish to learn more about.

To finish the term the learners have expressed they wish to learn about Scottish wildlife.
