## Consolidation Activities

### Maths:

Revise the following areas of maths. So far we have covered...

- Converting between different units of measurement in length, weight and volume.
- Fractions (Simplifying, equivalent, fraction of a number, improper/mixed number conversions)
- Properties of 2D and 3D Shape
- Symmetry
- Decimals - Adding and subtracting
- Time - 12/24 hour conversion, time durations and timetables.
- Information Handling - Creating and analysing bar, line and pie graphs.
- Adding and subtracting multiples of 10, 100 and 1000 to and from whole numbers and decimal fractions to two decimal places, adding and subtracting decimal fractions using tenths and hundredths
- Adding and subtracting up to 5 digit numbers using partitioning and formal methods)
- Multiplying and dividing numbers (mentally and written calculations using partitioning methods and chunking).
- Place Value (to millions)
- Ordering & sequencing and rounding of decimal and whole numbers up to 100,000
- Money - Adding and subtracting in different contexts.
