It would be great if the children could try a similar activity at home e.g. using a highlighter to highlight words they can find with the 'ew' or 'au' digraph. This could be from a magazine, newspaper, leaflet etc. We have provided a list of spelling words for you to try at home. It would be great if you could work on some spelling activities with the children to build and spell these words. Can you think of any other words featuring these digraphs? Can you write a sentence with these words? Can you spot them when your out and about? It would also be great if you could work on your new tricky words list. 

For the next two weeks we will be focusing on 'Partitioning'. This involves identifying how many 'tens' and 'ones' are needed to make up a number e.g. the number 35 is made up of 3tens which makes 30 and 5ones, and the number 52 is made up of 5tens which makes 50 and 2ones, we would show it like this;

Reading


