<u>Literacy</u>

Our new digraphs for next week will be 'ow'. The following week, we will be working on digraph 'ou'. Please click on the links below to watch Geraldine the Giraffe for our new sounds. I wonder what you can find in your home featuring our new digraphs. We will also be working on the story of 'ow' and 'ou' to find and write the missing words using our digraphs. It would be great if the children could try a similar activity at home e.g. using a highlighter to highlight words they can find with the 'ow' or 'ou' digraph. Maybe you could find your new digraph on some Christmas books or magazines. We have provided a list of spelling words for you to try at home. It would be great if you could work on some spelling activities with the children to build and spell these words. Can you think of any other words featuring these digraphs? Can you write a sentence with these words? Can you spot them when your out and about? It would also be great if you could work on your new tricky words list. Number

This week we have been focusing on rounding and estimating. It would be great if you could consolidate this learning at home. A fun activity that we have enjoyed is estimating how many items are in the jars. You could do this at home with pasta, sweeties, buttons, grapes, pebbles.....the list is endless. Make it a family fun game and count how many to find out who guessed the number closest to the total.

It would also be great if you could make your very own number line to estimate where the numbers would be. Try this from 0-10 and then 10-20. Perhaps try a challenge and make a big number line from 0-20. You could draw this outside using chalk or using crafty materials at home. Can you remember the rule for rounding to the nearest 10; if the number is 5 or more we round up to 10, if the number is 15 or more we round up 20. Can you round the numbers on your number to the nearest 10 eg, is 8 closer to 10 or 0, is 12 closer to 10 or 20.

We will be starting to look at 2D and 3D shapes. It would be great if you could name different shapes in the environment that you can see around you. We will be focusing on, circle, square, triangle, rectangle, hexagon, pentagon and octagon for 2D shape and sphere, cone, cube, cuboid and cylinder for 3D shape. Can you name the shapes? How many can you find?

Try this fun rounding game at home and remember to click up to 99 to nearest 10.

Sumdog


The children really enjoy playing Sumdog, please continue this at home. If you need a copy of your log-in details then please let us know and we will send it home with your child.
