


P1 have been so busy over the past few weeks! One of the children's most important jobs has been to write a letter to Santa








At Home

You can continue to support your child with their learning in many ways:

- Continue to encourage children to read and write their <u>Green Words</u> and Red Words.
- Please seek many opportunities to read, read! Remember that picture books can offer a wealth of opportunities to support children's reading comprehension, as well as creating many starting points for discussions around a story. With any of the children's books, do look for opportunities for children to spot their known sounds and tricky words within a book.
- Do remember that as we approach the end of term, our P1 children will likely get increasingly tired. It has been a long first term at school and they have been INCREDIBLY busy with their learning.
