

Holmston Primary School January 2021 Newsletter 1


The new year and Christmas already seem like a long time ago! We know that many of you have been able to access Teams or 2Simple depending on your child's class. We know initially there have been a few teething issues with the technology on a national level and more locally with parents having to re-install, have passwords changed and generally remembering how to work Teams. The same is true for the staff as more functions are now available to help support you and your child during this time. As you will know the First Minister has now stated that this period of lockdown will continue until mid-February which will be around the February holiday. We will await further information on the 2nd February.

We have listened to feedback and are trying to organise our Teams more consistently and we will try to ensure that work is easy to locate. Older files and folders will be archived.

During this lockdown, the video-calling feature has been opened and we hope your child has managed to join in with some of the class drop-ins or live sessions, including the maths sessions with Mr Morrow. All our classes have offered live check-ins. We are looking into how we can use voice overs in PowerPoints to further support your child at times that work for you - as we know not everyone can tune in at specific times.

We appreciate this is a challenging time again for all our families and there are many hardships and sacrifices that have to be made. With the home-learning, once again, do what you can, when you can. You have to make sure you are looking after yourselves too. In order to do this, you should make sure that any work does not become a fight. Don't worry if only some of it gets completed. Don't worry if you cannot do any work for a few days but please try to encourage your child to read, read! Let us know if you have any issues. Do what you can do and what works for you and your family. When we eventually get through this period, we have an excellent staff team that will make sure your child is exactly where they should be. Don't panic – you or your child will not be getting into bother! We just need you to keep in contact with us.
