Literacy and English



Reading: In class, pupils will be reading decodable texts. We will continue to revisit and learn new phonemes to enhance our phonics knowledge, allowing us to decode with confidence. We will also access books from the library for enjoyment.

Writing: Persuasive writing, Character and Setting.

Listening and Talking: Pupils will be sharing their thoughts and ideas during guided reading, answering literal questions about texts.

Numeracy and Mathematics



Place Value – We will be learning to read, write, partition and order numbers to 1000 or beyond.

Shape – We will be recognising 2D and 3D shapes, classifying and comparing shapes using mathematical language such as sides, corners and edges.

Estimation and Rounding – We will be estimating where numbers would place on a number line, rounding numbers to the nearest 10 and estimating quantities.

Addition and Subtraction – We will be learning to add and subtract 2-digit numbers and beyond.

Health and Well-Being and PE



Health and Wellbeing:

- Unit 1 Resilience

PE: Our PE days are Thursday and Friday. Our focus will be basketball and gymnastics.

Class Study (IDL/Topic)

Class book study – The Barnabus Project and Here We Are

Paddington (September–November)



Through the context of Paddington Bear, we will be exploring:

- making new relationships and our emotions.
- links to global citizenship and children's rights.
- mapping – looking at the UK and other countries.
- different housing.

Art and Design Contexts and Skills: Our focus will be on drawing skills and painting skills.

Painting Skills – We will be learning about the colour wheel. This will include children learning about warm and cool colours. Additionally, we will learn about primary and secondary colours through colour mixing.



Drawing Skills – Lines and Shapes

R.E: 'We will be learning about The Local Church. We will be learning about the key features inside and outside, what worship in church looks like and what celebrations happen in a church. We will also learn about places of worship in religions across the world.'



Music and Drama Contexts and Skills: We will take part in a block of music lessons with the YMI (Youth Music Initiative). This will happen on Friday mornings between 9.00-9.45am.

The class will focus on developing roleplay and focusing on creating characters.



Modern Languages Topics: We will be exploring Spanish vocabulary including greetings, days of the week, months of the year, colours, and numbers.
