Literacy and English



Reading: In class, pupils will be reading The Wild Robot by Peter Brown. Our focus will be on learning reading skills such as Fluency, Vocabulary and Comprehension skills. We will continue to revisit and learn new phonemes to enhance our phonics knowledge, allowing us to decode and encode with confidence.

Writing: We will focus on Character, Short Story, and Poetry

Listening and Talking: Pupils will be sharing their thoughts and ideas during guided reading, answering literal and inferential questions about texts.

RF:

We will be learning about Christianity and World Religions — focussing on how events are celebrated differently across the World

Numeracy and Mathematics



Symmetry — We will be learning about lines of symmetry in shapes and creating symmetrical patterns.

Time & Calendars — We will be learning to read analogue and digital times and be able to explain that there are 60 seconds in one minute, 60 minutes in one hour, 24 hours in one day. We will also learn how to calculate time durations using a calendar.

Multiplication & Division — We will continue to focus on our 3x and 4x tables through daily CLIC sessions. We will also learn some new strategies to help us with multiplication and begin to explore division.

 ${f Money}$ — To support our Enterprise Fortnight, we will be investigating money. We will learn how to mentally calculate total cost and change and convert pounds to pence.

The Human Body (November — December)

Through the context of The Human Body, we will be exploring:

- Senses

Enterprise (December)

Through the context of Enterprise we will be developing out entrepreneurial skills. This will lead us to our whole school Enterprise Market on Thursday 4th December.

Famous Scots (January - February)

Through the context of Famous Scots, we will be exploring:

- Sportspeople
- Musicians
- Historical Figures
- Artists

STEM (including Digital Technology) Contexts and links to Creativity:

Pupils will be visiting the ICT suite to learn touch typing, PowerPoint Publisher and Internet Safety. In class, we will also have regular opportunities to enhance our learning through the use of iPads.

We will cover lots of science through our Human Body topic.

We will also explore sustainability, through our Enterprise focus.



Art and Design Contexts and Skills:

We will be learning about textile and product design through art projects linked to our IDL topic and Enterprise.

Health and Well-Being and PE



Health and Wellbeing: We will be focussing on goal setting and working hard to achieve our set goals. We will be exploring the world of work and the skills and qualities required for different careers during Enterprise.
