Writing: Recount / Persuasive/Instructional writing linked to Enterprise / Narrative

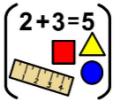
Listening and Talking: Pupils will share their thoughts and ideas during guided reading, answering literal, inferential and evaluative questions.

Health and Well-Being and PE

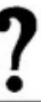
PE: Gymnastics / Dance
