Literacy and English



Reading and phonics: In class, pupils will be reading decodable texts. We will continue to revisit and learn new phonemes to enhance our phonics knowledge, allowing us to decode with confidence.

Writing: We will focus on are Short Story, Character and Poetry.

Listening and Talking: Pupils will be sharing their thoughts and ideas during guided reading, answering literal questions about texts.

Numeracy and Mathematics



Shape — We will be recognising 2D and 3D shapes, classifying and comparing shapes using mathernulcul language such as sides, corners and edges.

Expressions and equations – find missing numbers.

Money — mental calculations up to 20p, change from 20p, recognise coins and notes up to £20

Time — Recognise o'clock and half past on an analogue and digital clock, reading calendars, months of the year.

Angles, Symmetry and Transformation – purpose of compasses, directions, understand a line of symmetry.

Patterns and relationships - number sequences to 20, odd and even numbers
