Literacy and English



Reading and Phonics: In class, the children will be reading decodable and other texts. We will continue to revisit and learn new phoneme/grapheme correspondences to enhance our knowledge, allowing us to decode and encode with increasing confidence.

Writing: We will focus on: Explanation, Procedural and Report. The children will continue to develop their vocabulary, punctuation knowledge, and handwriting skills, to enhance their written work.

Listening and Talking: The children will be creating a talk about a topic, sorting ideas, using appropriate words and phrases, and focusing of pace, gesture, expression and emphasis. Note taking and mind maps.

Numeracy and Mathematics



Data Analysis – collecting organising and classifying data. Tally marks, pictograms, bar graphs and tables with rows & columns and frequency tables.

Multiplication and Division – focus on the connection between multiplication and division. Exploring the 2-, 4- and 8-times tables, the 5- and 10-times tables and then the 3- and 6-times tables.

Fractions – exploring halves, fifths, quarters and tenths. Showing fractions on a number line. Exploring equivalent fractions.

Measure – length – centimetres, mass – grams, volume & capacity – litres and half litres.

Ideas of Chance and Uncertainty – making predictions about the likelihood of an event occurring.

Class Study (IDL/Topic)

The Celts

The children will explore who the Celts were, their daily life, what they ate and drank, explore Celtic clothes and jewellery and roundhouses.



Shared IDL – British Wildlife

The children will learn about the classification of animals and plants. They will explore the physical features of different animals. They will learn about different animal habitats, food chains and endangered animals in Britain.

Art and Design

Drawing skills – showing increasing details in drawings and sketches.

Sculpture skills – working with clay, paper and card to make models.

ICT and Art – using a mouse to make controlled drawings.



Music and Drama

Drama – presenting short dramas and role-plays. Giving simple responses to evaluate others' dramas.



Music – understanding the beginnings of musical notation to play a variety of percussion instruments. Discussing how music makes us feel and evaluating others' performances.
